ACCESS by train

Matsue Station is operated by Japan Railways and is an inter-city railway station.

It can be quickly accessed by the **Limited Express Yakumo** running between Matsue and Okayama.

ACCESS by highway bus

Highway buses can be a reasonable option when travelling to Matsue. Highway buses connect Matsue and Tokyo (night bus only), Kyoto, Osaka, Fukuoka, Hiroshima, Okayama, Kobe, and Nagoya (night bus only).

ACCESS by plane

Izumo Airport
